CONTRACTIONS OF “TO BE”

Singular (1)

I am = I'm

you are = you're

he is = he's

she is = she's

it is = it's

Plural (2+)

we are = we're

you are = you're

they are = they're

Singular

I do I do not = I don't

she does she does not = she doesn't
it does it does not = it doesn't

Plural

we do we do not = we don't
you do you do not = we don't
they do they do not = don't

To the teacher: Although we try to avoid introducing new material in the Test Lessons, Lesson 4 has several new concepts. You may want to delay giving the test until the next class.

ORAL QUESTIONS

Review the oral questions in Lessons 1 to 3.

The students find the negative use of “to do” quite difficult but extensive oral practice will help them to make their responses automatic.

Do you have a brother?

Yes, I have a brother.

No, I don't have a brother.

Now turn to another student and ask:

Does he / she have a brother?

Yes, he / she has a brother.

No, he she doesn't have a brother.

Continue in the same way with these questions.

Do you have a dog?

Yes, I have a dog.

No, I don't have a dog.

Does he / she have a dog.

Yes, he / she has a dog.

No, he / she doesn't have a dog.

Continue using car, motorcycle, friend, drink, book, pen.

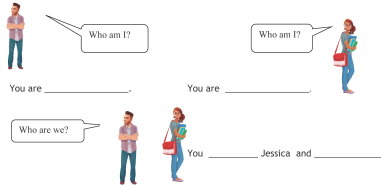

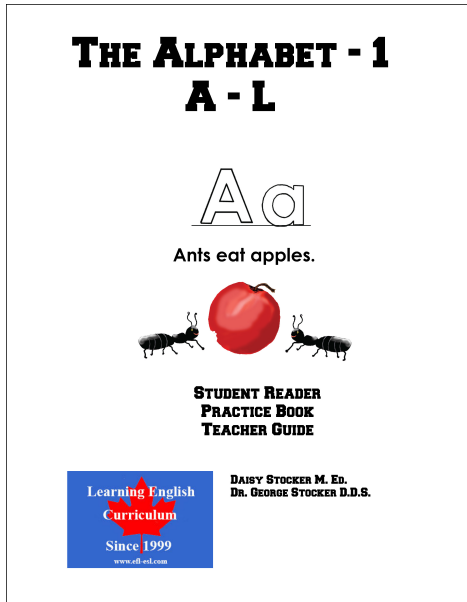

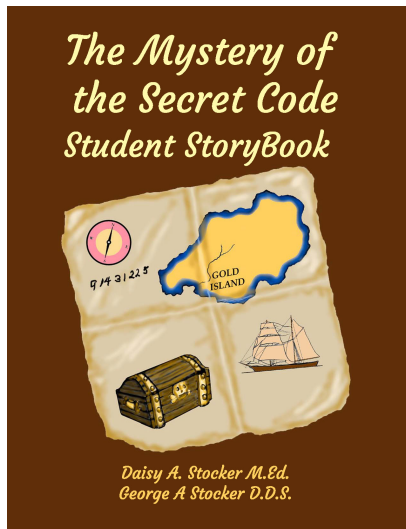
