To the teacher: Although we try to avoid introducing new material in the Test Lessons, Lesson 4 has several new concepts. You may want to delay giving the test until the next class.

ORAL QUESTIONS

Review the oral questions in Lessons 1 to 3.

The students find the negative use of "to do" quite difficult but extensive oral practice will help them to make their responses automatic.

Do you have a brother? Yes, I have a brother.

No, I don't have a brother.

Now turn to another student and ask:

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


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
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
